Committee Updates

- Colonial Park
 - September 14th Park Volunteer Day
 - Native garden planting, painting the basketball court/benches/backstop, continuing mural paintings
 - Mural design has be unveiled and will be installed September 28th
- National Night Out
 - Successful event with over 120 people in attendance
 - Net proceeds of the event were \$569 (with SMUD sponsorship)
 - Raffle with items from our local businesses raised \$236 for CHNA
 - Event sponsors: The Village Drive-In, Eric Guerra's office, SMUD
- Finance/Treasury
 - August Starting Balance: \$3,654.34
 - o Income: \$195 proceeds from NNO
 - o August Ending Balance: \$3,849.34

 - Shirts are now profitable
 - Linda requested revamping the street map shirt design
- Colonial Parkfest
 - October 5th 12-8pm
 - o Food vendors: Meza, Sr. Burger

 - Budget Review and Approval
 - Projected \$1,800 in spends (\$700 for shirts)
 - Requesting \$1,000 in seed money
 - Sarah motioned to approve giving the Parkfest \$1,000 in seed money. Greg seconded. Motion passed with no Nay's or Abstention.
- Bike Club (CHBC)
 - o Monthly rides every 3rd Sunday, meet at the park and decide where to go
 - Bonus rides: Halloween ride at night around the neighborhood, Fab 40's Christmas ride
- Communications
 - Keep current with CHNA information by subscribing to the newsletter, website, and social media channels
 - Wix is our website platform and we have hit our email limit
 - Sarah requested to increase the email limit (500 emails for 2 years)
 - Ian motioned to approve website maintenance expense.
 Chelsea seconded. Motion passed with no Nay's or Abstention.
