Mercy Housing California (MHC) is proposing to develop a new, 200home affordable community in the City of Sacramento. Located at 4995 Stockton Boulevard – south of the UC Davis Medical Center and proposed Aggie Square and just north of Fruitridge Road – this development will be within walking distance of public transit, grocery stores, schools, shopping, and recreation. Site amenities will include ample parking, landscaping, recreation areas, child-play areas, and a community building with onsite services and programming.
